## Online Tuition Payments

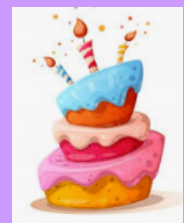
To pay your child's tuition online ---- Please go to the website for Crestview United Methodist Church: <https://www.violetcrown.church/>.

At the top of the home page is a 'Give Online' tab. This will take you to the donation page. You will then create a profile. There are several payment options. You can choose "Preschool tuition or Fees" to make a tuition payment. You will be able to choose your frequency of donations, as well as the start date and end date. We appreciate you using your bank account rather than a credit card if possible. We pay higher fees for credit card payments.

Remember to pay the \$100 supply fee for September only! Tuition is due the 1st of every month starting in September, and ending with May.
